Avoiding erosion, better watershed management

Erosion is a major challenge in many parts of the world and uncontrolled run-off is a major source of degradation - removing meters of fertile topsoil and leaving the roots of this ficus tree in Eastern Ethiopia completely exposed. Retaining and recharging water is the better option to safeguard watersheds and create strong buffers to overcome climate variabilities. Good land and water management is the key to secure livelihoods in some of the most vulnerable parts of the world.
